



AWARD GUIDELINES

The aim of the sponsors is to offer New Zealand Cystic Fibrosis persons of all ages the encouragement to strive for tangible awards that recognise their optimism, perseverance and achievement in a wide range of endeavours.

- A. Education: For academic achievement and perseverance in education from year 11 secondary school onwards, and including study at approved Tertiary Institutions such as Polytechnic, Teachers College or University.
- B. Endeavours in Sport: For perseverance or excellence in the Sporting field.
- C. Endeavours in Art: For perseverance or excellence in one of the Arts.
- D. Leadership: For commendable leadership in the community or for positive example to peers through courage and perseverance.

Explanatory Notes:

- 1. Awards are available to Cystic Fibrosis persons of all ages who are resident in New Zealand and members of the Cystic Fibrosis Association of N.Z.
- 2. Awards will be for a minimum of \$250 and a maximum of \$2500 at the discretion of the Board of Reference.
- 3. An award may not necessarily be made in each category each year.
- 4. At least one of the Awards each year will be made to a young person with Cystic Fibrosis of 15 years or less as at 31 January in that year.
- 5. A recipient of an Award in a specific category will be ineligible for any further Awards in that category, but will be eligible for an Award in a different category 2 years later.
- 6. Award applications may be made by a person with Cystic Fibrosis; or by an individual or Regional branch on behalf of a person with Cystic Fibrosis. Applications to reach the Chairman of the CF Achievers - Creon Awards Trust not later than 1st March 2010.
- 7. Applications will be considered and decided by a Board of Reference independent of the association or sponsors. Their decision will be made in March and announced in April each year.
- 8. All nominees will be contacted following the decision of the Board of Reference.
